6.	<u>25464</u>	Create a new 1.0 FTE position of Employee Assistance Specialist 2 in the Human Resources Department budget.
7.	<u>25487</u>	Amending Section 3.54(1)(b) of the Madison General Ordinances by deleting the classification of "Labor Relations Manager" in Compensation Group 18, Range 17, and creating the classification of "Employee and Labor Relations Manager" in Compensation Group 18, Range 17, thereof.
8.	<u>25465</u>	Retitle the current position #858 of Labor Relations Manager (CG18-17) in the Human Resources Department budget as Employee and Labor Relations Manager (CG18-17).

14.	<u>25376</u>	Establishing a voluntary program that would allow commissioned employees to voluntarily purchase heavy body armor (capable of stopping rifle rounds) for on-duty use, utilize the department's bulk purchasing power to order the body armor, and establish a repayment mechanism by which the cost of the heavy body armor would be recovered through deductions taken from the employee's paycheck.
15.	<u>25356</u>	Amending the 2012 Operating Budget for Engineering to fund a pilot program to perform landscape maintenance for traffic medians with City staff and appropriating \$15,000 from the Contingent Reserve.

16.	<u>25425</u>	Authorizing the execution of a Purchase Agreement with First Business Bank for a vacant property located at 733 S. Junction Road for the South Junction Road/CTH M reconstruction project.
17.	<u>25396</u>	To adjust the Child Care Assistance income guidelines to keep them in line with the poverty guidelines published by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services and adopted by the State and to reflect inflationary increases.
18.	<u>25416</u>	Adopting the Community Development Program Funding Goals and Objectives as a guide to the CDBG Committee for the development of its funding recommendations for the 2013 - 2014 budgets.
19.	<u>25455</u>	Authorizing the subordination of previously approved loans to Common Wealth Development and authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to sign agreements to subordinate the loans.
20.	<u>25477</u>	Authorizing Wisconsin Partnership for Housing Development (WPHD) to use returned Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP) program income funds in the amount of \$14,520.65 under the same terms as the current NSP contract between WPHD and City of Madison Community Development Division (CDD).
21.	<u>25561</u>	Authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute a development agreement to fund a \$3,432,000 Tax Incremental Finance Loan to The Constellation Project, LLC to assist in the development of housing and commercial redevelopment project located at 754 East Washington Avenue and 741 East Mifflin Street in a proposed project plan and boundary amendment to TID #36 (Capitol Gateway).
22.	<u>25423</u>	Authorizing the award of a grant of BREWD funds in an amount not to exceed \$200,000 to The Constellation Project LLC for the demolition, remediation, and redevelopment of property at 754 E. Washington Avenue and 741 E. Mifflin Street; rescinding RES-11-00546 (Legistar #22676) for a previously-approved \$325,000 BREWD grant; and, amending the adopted 2012 Adopted Budget of the Brownfields Remediation Revolving Loan Fund by reauthorizing \$325,000 in total grant expenditures, with \$200,000 in expenditures reallocated to the Constellation Project LLC, with the balance of \$125,000 available for future projects.
23.	<u>25582</u>	Discussion of Hovde Properties redevelopment proposal and its potential impact on the Fire Administration building and station 1.
