1. Amending Section 3.54(1)(b) of the Madison General Ordinances by deleting the classification of "Parking Enforcement Supervisor" in Compensation Group 18, Range 05, and recreating the classification of "Parking Enforcement Supervisor" in

Compensation Group 18, Range 08.

2.	<u>27511</u>	Recreate a 1.0 FTE Parking Enforcement Supervisor (CG18-05) position, currently occupied by S. Niesen (#3750), as a Parking Enforcement Supervisor in CG18, R08, within the Police Department budget and reallocate the incumbent to the new position.
3.	<u>27509</u>	Amending Section 3.54(1)(b) of the Madison General Ordinances by creating the classification of "Neighborhood Resource Coordinator" in Compensation Group 18, Range 10.
4.	<u>27469</u>	Create the classification of "Neighborhood Resource Coordinator" in CG18, Range 10, and allocate position #4391 to this new classification.
5.	<u>27530</u>	Authorizing a double-fill of a Transit Operations Supervisor
6.	<u>27404</u>	Authorizing the Mayor and the City Clerk to enter into an agreement with Meriter Health Services, Inc. for the provision of passes to its employees and volunteers for Metro Transit fixed route and ADA paratransit services, with reimbursement to the transit utility for employee and volunteer trips for the period December 1, 2012 through November 30, 2013 with one automatic renewal for the period December 1, 2013 through November 30, 2014.
7.	<u>27405</u>	Authorizing the Mayor and the City Clerk to enter into an agreement with SSM Health Care of Wisconsin, Inc., owning and operating St. Mary's Hospital Medical Center, for the provision of employee/volunteer passes for Metro Transit fixed route and ADA paratransit services, with reimbursement to the transit utility of \$1.15 per fixed route trip and the applicable paratransit price in the fare tariff at the time the ride is taken during the first year of the agreement (January 1, 2013 - December 31, 2013) and the applicable per ride price in the then current fare tariff at the time the ride is taken for all rides during the second year of the agreement (January 1, 2014 - December 31, 2014.)
8.	<u>27518</u>	Authorizing the Mayor and the City Clerk to enter into an agreement with Dane County for the purpose of providing the Transit Utility with State 85.21 funding given to Dane County for the provision of accessible transportation for eligible persons within Metro Transit's service area in the calendar year 2012.
9.	<u>27519</u>	Authorizing the Mayor and the City Clerk to enter into an agreement with Dane County to provide Group Access Service for the City of Madison for the calendar year 2012.
10.	<u>27520</u>	Authorizing the Mayor and the City Clerk to enter into an agreement with Dane County Human Services to provide Volunteer Driver Escort Services for the City of Madison for the calendar year 2012.
11.	<u>27545</u>	Transferring funds from Major Streets to Lien Road in order to close the Lien Road project.
12.	27347	Authorizing the City to participate in negotiations and, if necessary, arbitration with Dane County regarding the County's Rodefeld Landfill expansion application, and authorizing the Mayor to appoint members to the Rodefeld Landfill expansion local committee.

13.	<u>27497</u>	Approving a Parking agreement between the City of Madison (Parking Utility) and Bethel Lutheran Church, and authorizing the Mayor and the Clerk to sign the agreement.
14.	<u>27410</u>	Authorizing the Mayor, City Clerk and Chief of Police to accept the FY 2012 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant award in the amount of \$109,537 and to utilize these funds to support several law enforcement initiatives.
15.	<u>27515</u>	Authorizing the Chief of Police to host the Northwestern University School of Police Staff and Command (SPSC), and to execute a contract with Northwestern and accept registration fees for course attendance.
16.	<u>27523</u>	Authorizing the Mayor and Chief of Police to accept a grant totaling \$16,634 from the Wisconsin Department of Transportation for continuing the 2012-2013 Pedestrian/Bicycle Ambassador Program.
17.	<u>27390</u>	Approving Facade Improvement Grants to 1525 Williamson Street (Brew and Grow) and 2437 & 2439 Atwood Avenue (Madison Brewery).
18.	<u>27406</u>	Approving \$108,000 in Federal HOME funds to provide additional down payment assistance to qualified homebuyers through Movin' Out, Inc.
19.	<u>26893</u>	Accepting the report of the Emerald Ash Borer Taskforce and adopting the recommendations contained therein.
