The Common Council adopted a plan in 1996 to repair defective sidewalk throughout the City on a ten-year cycle. The plan was updated in 2002 and 2012 to reflect the completed work and to incorporate the reconstituted aldermanic districts. The 12th and 18th Aldermanic Districts have been scheduled for repair in 2013.

Offset, settled or badly cracked sidewalk sections are replaced with this program, the City and the abutting property owner each paying one half of the cost. The program is also used to install curb ramps at intersections. Curb ramps are funded solely by the City.

Estimated cost is \$1,636,000.00
