6.	<u>28838</u>	Authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to enter into an agreement with Isthmus Architecture, Inc. to provide professional architectural design services for the Madison Municipal Building Conceptual Schematic Design Study in the amount of \$198,543.
7.	<u>28645</u>	BY TITLE ONLY - Authorizing the provision of funds to Movin' Out, Inc. to assist with construction of mixed-income rental units, for households that include a member who has a permanent disability, located in the Greenbush neighborhood.
8.	<u>28646</u>	BY TITLE ONLY - Authorizing the provision of funds to Dane County Development Group to assist with the acquisition and rehab of two buildings located in the Burr Oaks neighborhood to be used as affordable rental housing.
9.	<u>28644</u>	SUBSTITUTE - Authorizing the provision of \$550,000 from the Affordable Housing Trust Fund and the Housing Development Reserve Fund to Care Net Pregnancy Center of Dane County, Inc. (Care Net). The loans will partially finance the development of 36 units of multi-family rental housing.
10.	<u>28774</u>	Approving the Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for the Judge Doyle Square project and directing follow-up actions for the Judge Doyle Square Committee.
11.	<u>28827</u>	Authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to amend the contracts with Vandewalle & Associates and The Hiebing Group for consultation services to implement the East Washington Avenue Capitol Gateway Corridor Plan and related projects within the Capitol East District ("District"), and authorizing the DPCED Director to hire additional outside consultant(s) to complete District-related work, with a recognition that all of the aforementioned contracts and contract amendments shall not exceed \$100,000 and are approved through December 31, 2013.
12.	<u>28828</u>	Authorizing the Director of the Department of Planning & Community & Economic Development to issue a Request for Proposals ("RFP") for consultant services to prepare a Madison Public Market Business Plan ("Business Plan"), authorizing a sub-committee of the Madison Local Food Committee to select the consultant(s) to prepare the Business Plan, and authorizing the City to execute a contract with the selected consultant(s) to prepare the Business Plan in an amount not to exceed \$250,000.
