- 1. 28974 Approving receipt of \$10,000 from the U.S. Conference of Mayors in recognition of the City of Madison's prescription drug abuse initiative; amending the budget of the Department of Public Health Madison and Dane County; and, authorizing the Board of Health for Madison and Dane County, on behalf of the Department of Public Health Madison and Dane County, to grant the money to Safe Communities, Inc.
- 2. <u>28927</u> Authorizing the Mayor, City Clerk and Chief of Police to accept two (2) public safety grants from the Wisconsin Department of Transportation for Pedestrian Safety Enforcement (\$4,000) and Bicycle Safety Enforcement (\$4,000)

5.	<u>28921</u>	Authorizing City officials and staff to enter into, accept and execute any and all documents needed to convert the existing unopened South Side Way (f.n.a. Raywood Road) right-of-way into developable park land to allow for the construction of a FEMA supported emergency weather event safe room within the Highland Manor manufactured home community.
6.	<u>28950</u>	Creating Section 8.32 of the Madison General Ordinances to establish a disc golf permit, and amending Sections 1.08(3)(a) and 1.08(4) of the Madison General Ordinances to create a bond schedule for violations of this permit requirement that is enforceable by the Parks Division
7.	<u>28542</u>	Authorizing the Mayor and the City Clerk to enter into an agreement with the consultant team of Kimley-Horn & Associates, Inc., for South Capitol Transit-Oriented Development (TOD) District Planning Study services for the City of Madison, and creating the South Capitol District Planning Committee.
8.	<u>28876</u>	Authorizing the sole source purchase of services from Isthmus Architecture for planning and technical services associated with the renovation of Monona Terrace Community and Convention Center.
		The Monona Terrace Community and Convention Center Board is scheduled to consider this item on 2-21-13.
9.	<u>28964</u>	Authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to sign a contract with Springsted Inc., for independent financial advisory services for fiscal years 2013, 2014, 2015, with an option to extend the contract for two subsequent fiscal years 2016 and 2017.
10.	<u>28966</u>	Authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to enter into an agreement with Midwest Art Conservation Center (MACC), for Aaron Bohrod Mural conservation services at the Madison Central Public Library at 201 West Mifflin Street.
11.	<u>28837</u>	SUBSTITUTE Authorizing the exercise of the Option to Purchase with John P. Schneider LLC for the acquisition of a condominium duplex located at 1409-1411 Theresa Terrace for potential use as a neighborhood center.
12.	<u>29019</u>	Resolution authorizing the approval of up to \$10,000 to pay for additional costs of providing shelter to homeless families and individuals on cold weather exception days, amending the 2013 adopted City operating budget to re-appropriate funds from Miscellaneous Appropriaitons, and authorizing the Mayor to execute an agreement with The Salvation Army of Dane County.

13.	<u>28873</u>	Authorizing the City of Madison, through the Community Development Division, to accept a \$5,000 grant from the State of Wisconsin Division of Community Corrections for Restorative Justice, Vocational and Employment Placement Services coordinated through the City of Madison Communities Against Violence project, amending the CDD 2013 operating budget, and authorizing the City to enter into purchase of service contract with the Construction Training, Inc. and YWCA for implementation of the grant.
14.	<u>29029</u>	SUBSTITUTE - Amending the 2013 Adopted Operating Budget of the Streets Division by appropriating \$38,336 from the Contingent Reserve to restore funding for the South Point Yard Waste Drop Off Site and restoring Sunday service to all three yard waste sites.
15.	<u>28695</u>	Expanding the Low Income Bus Pass Program and amending the Metro Transit 2013 operating budget by appropriating funds from the Contingent Reserve.

City of Madison, Dane County Circuit Court Cases No. 2011-CV-2201, No. 2010-CV-2615, No. 2009-CV-2695, No. 2008-CV-2390, No. 2007-CV-0928 and No. 2005-CV-0794, and granting limited exceptions to the billboard ban. The Plan Commission is scheduled to consider this item on 2-18-13.
20.	<u>28946</u>	Approving a Stipulation and Settlement Agreement with The Lamar Company, LLC, Lamar Outdoor Advertising of Janesville, and Lamar Central Outdoor, LLC (collectively, "Lamar"), and authorizing the City Attorney to execute the same, authorizing the City to enter into a lease with Lamar, and authorizing staff to permit Lamar to trim certain vegetation. The Plan Commission is scheduled to consider this item on 2-18-13.
21.	<u>28982</u>	Authorizing the execution of a contract with MSA Professional Services, Inc. and the expenditure of up to \$90,000 for Survey of Condition ("Blight Study") Services for the creation of Tax Increment Districts ("TIDs") and Redevelopment Districts.
