12. 33098 Approving plans and specifications and authorizing the Board of Public Works to advertise and receive bids for Yahara River Shoreline Repair & Olbrich Canoe Launch. (6th AD)

This project combines two small shoreline repair/improvement projects. The Yahara River Shoreline Repair work will consist of removing three sections of failing, wood retaining walls and replacing them with a combination of fieldstone riprap and limestone steps. The Olbrich Park Canoe Launch work will install a 30-foot section of cut limestone steps near the existing canoe racks in Olbrich Park. Estimated total project cost: \$127,186.55.

This project will have several specific landscaping jobs associated with it and will include bid items to be used at unspecified locations throughout the city as needs for landscape repair that comes up during the construction season. The contract bids these projects together in a group so they become more economical for a contractor. Two of the specific projects include smaller greenway repair work that is beyond the ability of our in house staff and too small to be bid individually. Projects will improve City stormwater management by repairing strom water channels. Greenway channel banks will be stabilized and vegetation will be restored where soil is exposed to reduce erosion. Projects will be throughout City greenways and other City owned properties. Total estimated cost of restoration project is \$75,000.
