7.	<u>29485</u>	Accepting the revised TIF Policy approved by the Economic Development Committee on February 20, 2013 for Common Council consideration and adoption.
8.	<u>32909</u>	Authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to enter into an agreement with Isthmus Architecture, Inc. to provide additional architectural and engineering design services related to Design Development, Construction Documents, Bidding and Construction Administration for the rehab of a duplex for use as the Theresa Terrace Neighborhood Center.
