RESOLUTIONS APPROVING THE CONSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC WORKS PROJECTS

24. <u>37268</u> Approving plans and specifications and authorizing the Board of Public Works to advertise and receive bids for the construction of Capital City Path Reconstruction and Bridge Replacement. (6th & 15th AD)

The Capital City Path is the primary multi-use path on Madison's East side. The segment from Marquette Street to Dennett Drive, constructed about 1987, is in poor condition and the existing 8-foot width does adequately serve the large number of users. The clear width on the existing bridge of 8 feet is considerably below current minimum standards. The existing wood plank deck requires frequent maintenance. There are existing flooding problems in several locations.

The project will reconstruct and widen approximately 3700 feet of path, replace the existing bridge with a steel bridge with concrete deck, and replace approximately 2150 feet of storm sewer with larger diameter sewer, including upgrade of the existing storm outfall into Starkweather Creek.

The path widening and storm work will require minor, temporary grading within the railroad corridor, for which a permit from WisDOT is required. In two locations the path requires very minor use of Olbrich Park property, approved by Board of Parks Commissioners on February 25, 2015.

Estimated cost is \$870,500.
