11.	<u>37864</u>	Amending the 2015 Adopted Operating Budget to Transfer Funds related to a Study of Community Policing and Body Cameras from the Police Department budget to the Mayor's Office budget.
12.	<u>37753</u>	Authorizing the execution of a First Amendment to the Lease for space within the building located at 30 West Mifflin Street for the temporary relocation of administrative space for the City of Madison's Fire Department.
13.	<u>37783</u>	Adopting and confirming the Agreement between the City of Madison and the Association of Madison Fire Supervisors (AMFS) for the period March 10, 2014 to December 31, 2015.
