Discussion of the status of the City's electronics recycling program..Body The City of Madison has been part of a group of communities that contract for electronics recycling. This group approach has resulted in better pricing for the program. In June, new bids were sought and the group made a switch from URT Recycling to 5R Processors. The new agreement took effect on July 1. Since the change in vendors, the Streets Division has encountered significant problems with 5 R processors doing timely pick ups. This has resulted in large numbers of TV's and other items sitting in yards at our drop off sites at Badger Rd and Sycamore Av. After numerous attempts to get the problem solved, the Streets Division has received permission to leave the group and contract with URT for the next six months. This will result in slightly higher costs for the City.
