The purpose of the project is to replace approximately 850 feet of old, undersized and break-prone cast iron water main with new 8" ductile iron main on E. Broadway Service Rd from Femrite Dr to E. Broadway. This portion of the E. Broadway Service Road is slated for resurfacing in 2017; a secondary objective is to install the new water main ahead of the road being resurfaced. Estimated cost is \$312,000.

12. Approving plans and specifications and authorizing the Board of Public Works to advertise and receive bids for New Sidewalk Installation 2016.

This project includes the installation of new sidewalk along the south side of Drake Street from Grant Street to South Randall Avenue, installation of new sidewalk along the east side of South Whitney Way from WB Beltline Off-Ramp to Odana Lane, and installation of sidewalk and a bus pad on the south side of Anderson Street just east of its intersection with Wright Street. Estimated cost is \$100,000.

This project includes the dredging of sediment from a short (approximately 200 feet in length) reach of Willow Creek immediately north of the creek's intersection with Campus Drive, at the primary discharge point of the City's storm sewer, and the installation of an in-creek concrete-lined channel and weir for sediment capture and control. The project also includes the re-alignment of approximately 85 feet of 6'x10' concrete box culvert storm sewer to improve hydraulics in the City's storm sewer system. The project is located immediately downstream of where the City of Madison storm sewer discharges into Willow Creek, northwest of the veterinary medicine complex on the University of Wisconsin – Madison campus. Estimated the cost of this project is \$877,800.
