N. Bassett Street Sewer Sanitary sewer work will include pipe bursting the 400' long sewer on North Bassett Street from University Ave to W. Johnson Street. The sewer will be upgraded from a 12" diameter sewer to a 15" diameter sewer. The primary reason for the sewer upgrade is the proposed 348 unit, 830 Bedroom building under construction at 510 University Ave. Estimate Project Cost: \$142,000.

N. Bedford Street sewer work will include upsizing the North Bedford Street from an 8" diameter sewer to a 10" diameter sewer with a pipe burst. The primary reason for this project is maintenance related (poor pipe condition in W Dayton St) but there is an 179 unit, 372 bedroom apartment building at 110 N. Bedford Street that will be the primary customer of this sewer. Sanitary Project Cost: \$73,000.

The proposed project is a Cure-In-Place-Pipe (CIPP) lining rehabilitation of sanitary sewer mains. The project is focused on the rehabilitation of sanitary sewer mains that are located in high groundwater areas where inflow and infiltration is present in the sanitary sewer mains. The projects goal is to help prevent I/I from entering the sanitary sewer system, which decreases the amount of water that needs to be treated by MMSD and ultimately reduces the cost of sewer service to the Sewer Utility customers. The project location is spread throughout the city, with a majority of the work taking place in the Wright St area. Estimated cost of the project is approximately \$500,000.00.
