Spooner Street. The existing bank building and associated parking lot will be razed to redevelop the site for a new mixed-use building. The street, curb, sanitary service lateral and water service lateral improvements will be constructed with the City's Monroe Street reconstruction project. The Developer will be responsible for the sidewalk, terrace restoration, street trees, street

lighting, and storm sewer service laterals required to serve and adjacent to the development. The 1722 Monroe Street development will be required to coordinate work and access requirements with the City's Monroe Street reconstruction project.

The annual bridge inspections have identified the need for repairs on several of the city bridges. Bottom deck repairs are needed on the Campus Drive Bridges over Highland Avenue and Walnut Street, spot repairs are needed on the John Nolen Drive Bridges. The Milwaukee Street Bridge over the west branch of the starkweather creek and East Washington Avenue Bridge over the Yahara River and the west branch of the Starkweather Creek will have polymer overlays to protect the bridge decks.
