The Pinney Library will be located in the Ruedebusch Development & Construction's (RDC) "Royster Corners" mixed use development located at the intersection of Cottage Grove Road and Dempsey Road. The City of Madison is negotiating a purchase and sale agreement with RDC for 20,000 square feet of first floor space. The Pinney Library project involves tenant improvements to finish the gray box condominium space including framing of interior spaces, installation of mechanical (including geothermal field), electrical, plumbing, fire protection and audio visual systems, and installation of finishes, equipment, and furniture. Estimated cost of this project is \$4,800,000.
