9.	<u>55081</u>	SUBSTITUTE- Authorizing the City of Madison to accept up to \$150,000 in funds from 1000 Friends of Wisconsin, Inc. and amending the 2019 Planning Division operating capital budget to reflect this revenue, and to authorize the City to enter into a sole source service contract with Julia Schilling for the creation of <i>Shift</i> , a public art installation at Highland Avenue Underpass beneath Campus Drive.
10.	<u>55018</u>	Resolution Requesting Dane County Eliminate its Policy on Requiring Jurisdictional Transfer of County Highways
