17.	<u>57228</u>	Authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute a lease with MDI Regent Madison Hotel, LLC allowing for the use of a portion of the City-owned transportation corridor parcel located at 650 West Washington Avenue for private open space, walkway, storm sewer and landscaping purposes.
