RECOMMEND AWARD TO CREAM CITY CONCRETE CONTRACTORS

Contract 8465 is a rebid of Contract 9397. For this rebid we reduced the scope from three truck scales to one, and concrete work only, other work is to be performed by city staff or other contractors. This bid received only one bidder, it was under the engineer estimate, and Streets Division needs this scale operational before winter. A third rebid would be detrimental to the project time table.

The City Engineer requests that the Board of Public Works makes their finding in the

best interest of the City to waive minor irregularities in the bid.

The City is allowed to waive minor irregularities. After review by the City Attorney's Office, the City Engineer recommends the irregularities be waived.

Minor Irregularities: (Contractor was given 6 hours to correct these minor irregularities)

- 1. The form of the bid bond was not correct. The Bidder has corrected.
- 2. Forms B. E. and F were mislabeled. The Bidder has corrected.
- 3. Unit prices were not provided however the total was provided. The Contractor has provided the unit prices to match the total.
- 4. Bonding Agent not licensed in Wisconsin. The Bidder has corrected.
- 22. Storm Structural Repairs 2019. (10th & 14th ADs)

RECOMMEND AWARD TO R. G. HUSTON CO., INC.

The bid is higher than the engineer's estimate for the work. However, this work involves significant mobilization of varied crews and equipment for small, specialized quantities of work, in addition to the purchase of small quantities of specialized materials. Due to the unique nature of the projects there was little guidance on the cost estimate, however review was completed by our structural consultant to determine if the bids were in the realm of probable cost. Engineering believes that re-bidding the work in the future would not result in significantly lower bids. Moreover, the Arboretum Pond 3 screen structure, which is included in the contract for repair, is in poor condition, and Engineering is concerned that further failure of the structure could result if repairs are postponed.
