Recommend approval with the following changes: Thus, reducing reliance on plastic beverage straws and stir sticks is one way Madison can help ensure that these products, which are used briefly but can take nearly 200 years to decompose, do not unnecessarily harm the environment. This ordinance is not meant to discourage restaurants from having straws on site for customers who may wish to use them, including specifically for individuals with disabilities who may depend on straws to consume a beverage. (2) Restrictions. It shall be unlawful for a restaurant to prepare a drink with a plastic straw or plastic stir stick for a dine-in customer unless the restaurant asks the dine-in customer if they want a plastic straw or stir stick. This ordinance does not prohibit a restaurant from providing a plastic beverage straw or plastic stir stick to a take-out customer or making plastic straws or plastic stir sticks available for dine-in customers to take voluntarily. This ordinance also does not prohibit the restaurant from providing a straw upon a dine-in customer's request. Page 23, Canopy Coverage, Goals - Add an additional bullet to this section as follows:

Canopy strategies should place a priority on the protection of existing large <u>or very old</u> trees throughout the City. Special heritage protection should be considered for large burr oaks wherever they occur, in recognition of their place in pre-settlement oak savannas.

Page 24, Recommendation #6 - Revise as follows: "Dedicate additional resources to Forestry for more frequent pruning and maintenance of new and existing street trees. The current approximately 21 -year pruning cycle of street trees should be evaluated in order identify methods and resources needed to shorten the cycle. <u>Resources should</u> also be dedicated to replanting more promptly."

Page 24, Recommendation #7 - Revise as follows: "The Park Commission should prepare a policy of and develop methods for canopy growth within parks <u>with the goal of _by</u> planting 2,000 more trees above the replacement rate each year for the next five years, <u>taking into account existing park policies (park master planning and land management,</u> <u>etc.)</u>, park values (sight lines, viewsheds, no-mow prairie areas, etc.) and other park <u>uses (active recreation as well as passive recreation opportunities) to create a diverse</u> <u>and balanced park system as identified in the Park and Open Space Plan</u>, and-how-it could interact with other park-uses (e.g., no-mow-areas). An assessment for park properties should be completed in order to identify preliminary tree locations, set consistent design_goals, and project both-priority areas and rates for tree planting. In addition, a tree preservation plan or criteria should be developed for Parks. "

Page 25, Recommendation #15 - Revise as follows: <u>"The Habitat Stewardship</u> <u>Subcommittee is a subcommittee of the Board of Park Commissioners; with the transfer of</u> the Forestry Section to the Streets Division effective 2020, several modifications to the ordinance will be required as the Habitat Stewardship Subcommittee will still have <u>purview over land management, including trees, on park lands though they may no longer</u> have the same purview over trees in the ROW.
