1. <u>56637</u> Recreate the Accounting Technician 2 (CG 20, Range 14) position #1029 into an Administrative Analyst 2 (CG18, Range 8) in the CDA Housing Division's operating budget to be filled through an internal competitive process.

- 2. <u>56638</u> Create the classification of Customer Service Ambassador in CG16, R04 and recreate the following positions of Parking Cashier as Customer Service Ambassadors in the Parking Division operating budget: 1.0 FTE position #3999, 0.9 FTE position #1288, and 0.6 FTE position #3461.

- 5. 56586 Adopting and confirming the Labor Agreement between the City of Madison and the Association of Madison Fire Supervisors (AMFS) for the period January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2021.
- 6. <u>56594</u> A Resolution authorizing a non-competitive selection contract for a one year term with four one year renewal options, for snow plow wear items i.e. plow cutting edges with Burke Truck & Equipment.
