This project will transition a selection of newly reconstructed or existing medians from turf to a low-mow pollinator friendly turf, or a short-grass prairie mix. The Contractor will maintain previously seeded medians for the fall of 2019, and prepare and seed additional existing turf medians in the fall of 2020. The proposed plan will reduce mowing needs in trial medians from once every 7-14 days, to 1-3 times a season. The project will also reduce emissions and labor costs, protect operators in high-speed, high-traffic medians, create pollinator habitat and improve aesthetics along Madison's roads.
