The Developer, CJK, INC., has obtained conditional approval from the City for a Certified Survey Map and redevelopment of the site with a six-story mixed use building at 502 W Washington Avenue. This is the western corner of the intersections of W Washington Avenue and N Bassett Street. Public improvements will mostly be replacement of any damaged or removed sidewalk or curb as well as the private utility service lateral connections. The existing Metro Bus stop adjacent to the site on W Washington Avenue is to be expanded as a condition of approval for the redevelopment as is construction staging and access due to the limited access available from W Washington Avenue and N Bassett Street. City street tree protection and replacement will be required as part of the project.
