Florencio-Morales into the new position at Metro Transit.
4.	<u>59080</u>	Delete the classification of Disability Rights and Services Program Coordinator in CG 18, Range 8 and create a new classification of Disability Rights and Services Program Coordinator in CG 18, Range 10. Recreate position number #0076 to a Disability Rights and Services Program Coordinator (CG18, R10), and reallocate incumbent J. Glozier into the new CG and Range.
5.	<u>59079</u>	Create new classifications of Assistant Construction Manager 1 & 2 in CG18, R6 and 8, and create new classifications of Construction Manager 1 & 2 in CG 18, R10 & 12 respectively and delete the existing classification of Construction Manager in CG 18, R10. Recreate the two Construction Manager positions #4623 and #4522 as a Construction Manager 2 and reallocate the incumbents to the level of Construction Manager 2.
6.	<u>59082</u>	Create the classification of Building Maintenance Coordinator in CG 16, Range 16 in the salary schedule; and recreate the new positions #4813, 4814, 4815 as a Building Maintenance Coordinator in the CDA Housing Division's operating budget.
7.	<u>59086</u>	Recreate #696 from a Program Specialist 2 (CG17, R12) to an Accounting Technician 3 (CG20, R16) in the Economic Development Division operating budget and reallocate the incumbent (A. Freedman) to the new position.
8.	<u>59089</u>	Recreate position #4664 from a 1.0 FTE Maintenance Worker (CG16, R11), currently occupied by J. Rosol, to a 1.0 FTE Maintenance Mechanic 1 (CG16, R13) in the Water Utility budget and reallocate the incumbent to the new position.
9.	<u>59090</u>	Reallocate the incumbent of position #1776, R. Planert, from a 1.0 FTE Maintenance Mechanic 1 (CG16, R13) to the 1.0 FTE budgeted position of Maintenance Mechanic 2 (CG16, R15) in the Water Utility budget.
10.	<u>59083</u>	Delete the classification of Transit Building Maintenance Foreman in CG 44, Range 9 and create a new classification of Transit Building Maintenance General Supervisor in CG 44, Range 10. Recreate position number #2678 to a Transit Building Maintenance General Supervisor (CG44, R10), and reallocate incumbent J. Fink into the new CG and Range.

11.	<u>59078</u>	Accreting CG17 employees into CG20, 18, and 44, where appropriate, creating new classifications in CG20 to accommodate the movement of employees, creating a new classification of Administrative Supervisor in CG18, R03, and Transit Administrative Supervisor in CG44, R03, recreating the various positions in their new CG and Range, and reallocating the incumbents to the new positions.

14.	<u>59145</u>	Authorizing the noncompetitive purchase of more than \$50,000 in goods from Frank Beer Distributors LLC as a sole source provider of certain brands of fermented malt beverages to be sold at the City of Madison Golf Courses in 2020.
15.	<u>58351</u>	Authorizing the Mayor and the City Clerk to enter into a Monumental Signage Use (Lease) Agreement with Washington Gilman, LP and Mullins Family, LLP beginning in November 2019 and continuing month-to-month unless either party cancels the agreement with at least 30 days notice.
16.	<u>58966</u>	Authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute a parking lease agreement with Hovde Building, LLC, for 20 - 75 parking stalls at the State Street Capitol parking garage.
17.	<u>59139</u>	Amending the 2020 Engineering Major Streets Capital Budget to transfer \$510,000 of existing GO borrowing authority between major program W. Washington Avenue project, Wilson Street project and Monroe Street project to the Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard project and transfer \$100,000 of special assessment revenue authority from Reconstruction Streets major to the Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard project. (4th and 13th AD)
18.	<u>59194</u>	Amending the 2020 Stormwater Utility Operating Budget to fund additional watershed studies for the Willow Creek Watershed and the Yahara River/Isthmus Watershed.
19.	<u>59149</u>	Issuance of Industrial Development Revenue Bonds for the purpose of refinancing the \$19,300,000 original principal amount City of Madison, Wisconsin Industrial Development Revenue Refunding Bonds, Series 2002B (Madison Gas and Electric Company Project) and financing additional capital projects for Madison Gas and Electric Company
