- 6. 62004 Approving funding recommendation of the Madison Arts Commission for a total of \$5,000 in public art funding from the Municipal Art Fund for Alicia Walter's Black Thought Wall installation at the Village on Park and authorizing the Planning Division Director to execute the contract.

10.	<u>61728</u>	SUBSTITUTE - Authorizing the City's Economic Development Division to submit for a \$250,000 grant, and if awarded, accept a grant for \$250,000 from the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation (WEDC) Idle Sites Redevelopment Grant program and, if awarded, amending the 2020 Adopted Operating Budget for Economic Development Division-Office of Business Resources' purchased services and authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to enter into a contract with WEDC to accept Idle Sites Redevelopment Grant award and enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with JT Klein Company, Inc. for use of the funds.
