2. 74454 Awarding up to \$8,950,000 from the Affordable Housing Fund to support three affordable housing development projects, selected through a City Request for Proposals (RFP) process, that will support construction of approximately 500 units of new rental housing in Madison, 344 of which will be affordable, and authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute loan agreements with the developers of those projects.

3. 74456 Awarding up to \$1.65 million from the City's Affordable Housing Fund (AHF) to help finance the development of affordable housing, up to \$1.25 million in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds and up to \$1.1 million in HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME) funds to support seven housing services programs, and up to \$100,000 in City levy to support two homebuyer education programs; and authorizing the sale of five lots, as the recommended outcomes of a competitive "Housing Forward: Financing for Homeownership" Request for Proposals (RFP) process conducted by the Community Development Division; and authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to enter into agreements with those agencies to implement the specified development and services projects.
