Superintendent Eric Knepp reported that Parks is wrapping up another very busy year that included extremely high permit sales and park use. Staff are busy preparing for the winter season. Despite a decrease in holes available due to the Glenway project, Golf has had another very successful season. Parks has prepared and secured Alder support for a budget amendment that converts existing funding to 1.25 additional positions, which is being considered by Council as the operating budget is finalized. Assistant Superintendent Lisa Laschinger provided a brief introduction of our new Executive Director of Olbrich Botanical Gardens, Tanya Zastrow, who started on November 1st.
