The current CARES pilot appears to have gotten off to a slow start because the 911 center wasn't referring calls. For this program to reach its potential as soon as possible, we need leaders who will insist that all community partners work hard to ensure its success.

It's not entirely clear to me whether CARES currently is driving forward as vigorously as it could, or if it is a bit adrift.

We need a chief who has experience and demonstrated commitment to emergency medical services like CARES.
