Shots Fired Incidents:

- 13 total incidents in December 2021

- 231 total shots fired incidents in 2021 compared to 250 shots fired incidents in 2020
 - o 7.6% decrease from 2020-2021
- 40 casings recovered in December; 876 total in 2021
