Synthesis of outreach discussion and recommendations to date

Outreach Elements	Strategies & Guidance
Targeted Engagement	 With subsistence anglers, Hmong community, potentially others regarding fishing and ways to meet their needs (diet, cultural, budget) in healthier way. Follow RESJI best practices & coordinate w/ DCR.
General Engagement at Community Meetings	 Meet people where they are. Continue availability for local neighborhood meetings & events. Set targets for outreach activities. Listen first. Hear and recognize their concerns & experiences. Provide information that's relevant and share how to get more information. Educate and empower staff to represent full range of issues.
Improved Information Access	 Prepare a short, clear "Guide to PFAS in Madison" to share non-siloed, clear information. Add a PFAS landing page to the City website that links to other PFAS resources as supports clear online "wayfinding" for PFAS information.
Regular Updates	 Quarterly update to the relevant BCC on progress with Targeted Engagement Quarterly update to the "Guide to PFAS in Madison" Monthly updates to PHMDC website of PFAS-related news, status, & activities
