Hello,

I am writing to advocate for traffic calming measures at the Westfield Road and Farmington Way intersection. I live in Walnut Grove near this intersection and use it frequently. I have two young children and this intersection is our direct access to the Walnut Grove Park. The main issues that I experience is the rate of speed of vehicles passing through the area and the curve of the road combined with the lack of signage or attention to the intersection. Vehicles are consistently driving over the speed limit and pedestrians cannot see around the curve heading west to cross Westfield. I have had many close calls while trying to cross with my children where cars either can't see us or are going over the speed limit. In addition, we have had an influx of new, young families move to the neighborhood in the last 3 years. These young families love having access to the park and green spaces, however, many have shared concerns about the intersection being unsafe to cross with young kids.
