
Q1 What is your relationship to the project area?





20	Traffic calming would be very welcome on 4th street. I have hesitations about several of the elements proposed. 1. Three speed humps seems excessive. Having driven on other streets with humps this often it seems like more than are needed and inhibit reasonable transit on the street. 2. I am concerned about the impact of parking on this street for residents. The design changes will certainly reduce parking capacity somewhat. Given this, the changes should not be made without parking changes that account for the resident need for parking and limit school parkers (which is currently not done). 3. Third, work should be done with the school to manage traffic and student drop off and pick up near the school. The area would be safer if this was done on E. Wash and not 4th Street. There should be shared bus and auto drop off on E. Wash and 4th Street should be enforced as a no pick up/no stopping/no standing area. 4. I am concerned the design changes may further impact the poor snow clearing on 4th street in the winter and poor street cleaning in the warmer months. Because the street has parking only on one side, the street is rarely cleared curb to curb of snow. I worry the speed humps will further limit the ability for the street to be plowed well. Likewise, our street does not get swept well, particularly in the spring. This was particularly true since the recent chip sealing that was done. We still have a significant excess of gravel/chips that continue to accumulate. (in contrast to surrounding streets that were cleaned and are largely free of that debris now).
