

Madison BCycle Historical Trip Data




2021 in Review

- **309**k total trips taken
- Mobile checkouts accounted for 74% of all checkout attempts.
- accounted for 45% of trips, Monthly Members
- We continue to rollout the latest technology to better serve our riders.

2021 HEATMAP


Avg. Trip Durations:

2021 New Stations


- 9 new stations totaling 71 new docks
- Positioned to help expand recreational ridership.
- Set us up well for further expansion in the future.






Planned UW Stations 2022

- 8 new stations totaling 64 docks.
- These stations will help alleviate pressure on our current stations on the UW Campus.
- Provide stations closer to UW housing facilities.




Planned TAP Grant stations: Madison

- 11 planned stations totaling 100 bikes as well as adding 55 e-bikes.
- Will help us place stations in areas that have greatest need and reliance on public transportation.
- The focus of these stations is to reach underserved parts of Madison.
- More locations near libraries, parks and community services



Planned TAP Grant stations: Fitchburg

- 10 planned stations totaling 100 docks, as well as adding 55 ebikes.
- Focus is to help expand BCycle to Fitchburg.
- These stations will take advantage of the excellent bike path system to further connect the greater Madison area.





Community Pass Program


- Back for 2022: Community

Vision for 2022 & Beyond

Increase access: Bike share as transit
