Re: Proposed Contaminated Soil Assessment & Public Hearing

The City of Madison is proposing to reconstruct the public sanitary sewer main located in a sanitary sewer easement in the parking lot area of the property at 1622 Fordem Avenue in the summer of 2022. Through the design process, soil borings were taken at the project location and it was discovered that there were contaminated soils present at the project location. With the contaminated soils being found on private property, the property owner where such soils are discovered is responsible for remediation costs of those soils. If the project is approved, the cost for the excavation, hauling, and disposal of all contaminate soils discovered during installation of the new sanitary sewer main will be assessed back to the property owner.

Enclosed with this letter is a Schedule of Assessments, which shows the estimated cost for the excavation, hauling, and disposal of contaminated soils. After the work is complete, a final assessment will be calculated based on bid prices and work actually performed. The final assessment, which will be billed after the completion of the project, is payable in one lump sum or over a period of 8 years, with 2% interest charged on the unpaid balance.
