## PSRC Meeting, 05/11/2022

Items of Significance since last meeting:

- One homicide in the month of April-Madison's 2<sup>nd</sup> of 2022
  - Case assigned to our Special Victims Unit

Shots Fired Incidents:

- 14 total incidents in April of 2022
  - YTD 2021-2022, 62 shots fired incidents
- 3 year comparison:
  - o **2019-12**
  - o **2020-15**
  - o **2021-14**
  - o 3 Year Average: 14 (2.4% increase over 3 years)
- Quarterly Report:
  - $\circ$   $\,$  48 shots fired, 17% decrease from 2021  $\,$ 
    - 29 from 4p-MN, 13 from MN-8a, 6 from 8a-4p
  - Property Damage: 16
  - o Subjects Struck: 9
  - Casings recovered: 179

Strategic Plan Update:

- MPD's steering committee met with Matrix Consulting Group (MCG) on 04/05 to discuss next steps
- MPD received recommendations from MCG on 04/25 regarding next steps in the work group formation
- Creation of 4-5 work groups which include internal and external stakeholders (within 4-6 weeks)
- Recommendations include:
  - $\circ$   $\,$  60% civilian and 40% police  $\,$
  - $\circ$  Each group to have two co-chairs (1 civilian and 1 police) and 1 secretary
  - $\circ$  Groups should be in place the length of the plan (5-7 years)
    - o Initial monthly meetings followed by quarterly meetings (or determined by the work group)
    - Group to report out quarterly on progress to ensure accountability
- Next steps: MPD does not have MCG's recommendation for work group pillars at this time
  - $\circ$  Once these groups are isolated, MPD and MCG will work together on member selection
