




<u>CITY WIDE:</u> There were 14 reported shots fired incidents in the month of April.



April 2022 - Burglaries

<u>City Wide:</u> There were at least 51 burglary cases in the month of April.

Year to Date: There have been at least 190 burglary cases since January 1st, 2022.

3 Year Comparison (April):

• 2019: 85

• 2020: 87


2021: 48

• 3-year average: 73

The 51 burglaries in April 2022 is a 30% decrease over the previous 3-year average.

Stolen Autos per District: Midtown: 9, West: 8, South: 2, Central: 14, North: 9, East: 9

What: During the course of the 51 reported burglaries, 2 firearms were stolen and 12 victims reported being home at the time.





April 2022 – Heroin Overdoses

<u>City Wide:</u> There were at least 18 heroin overdose calls for service in the month of April. There was 1 fatal heroin overdose in the month of April.

Year to Date: There have been at least 59 heroin overdose calls for service since January 1st, 2022.


3 Year Comparison (April):

The 18 heroin overdoses in April 2022 is a 27% decrease over the previous 3-year average.

April 2022 - Stolen Autos

<u>City Wide:</u> There were at least 31 stolen auto calls for service in the month of April. 29 have been recovered.

Year to Date: There have been at least 175 stolen auto calls for service since January 1st, 2022.

3 Year Comparison (April):

2020: 30


• 2021: 48

3-year average: 37

The 31 stolen autos in April 2022 is a 16% decrease compared to the previous 3-year average.

<u>Stolen Autos per District:</u> Midtown: 4, West: 7, South: 6, Central: 4, North: 6, East: 4

What: Of the 31 autos stolen in April, 15 had keys in them or easily accessible. 5 were unlocked and running at the time of the theft.





April 2022 – Theft from Auto

<u>City Wide:</u> There were at least 45 TFA offenses in the month of April.

Year to Date: There have been at least 163 TFA offenses since January 1st, 2022.

3 Year Comparison (April):

• 2019: 96 • 2020: 14

• 2020: 141

• 2021: 53

• 3-year average: 97

The 45 TFAs in April 2022 is a 53% decrease over the previous 3-year average.

TFAs per District: West: 11, Midtown: 15, South: 3, Central: 4, North: 5, East: 7

What: Of the 45 TFAs in April, 22 were forced entry & 29 were no-force or unlocked.
