Patrons under the age of twenty-one (21) shall not be on the emise more than thirty (30) minutes before the scheduled live entertainment and must be off the termise within thirty (30) minutes of the live entertainment concluding.

Patrons under the age of twenty-one (21) may only be on the portion of the licensed premise where the live entertainment is occurring with the exception of incidental use of the restroom facilities and procuring a non-alcoholic beverage from the barroom. Under no circumstances will underage patrons be allowed to linger in a barroom that is separate from the live entertainment portion of the premise.
