- 4. A defining characteristic of the Lake Monona Waterfront project area is that it encompasses a key segment of the city's multimodal transportation network (the Capital City Trail Path). What past experiences or projects will inform how your team tackles the multimodal transportation aspect of the Lake Monona Waterfront project?
- 5. Do you see an opportunity to reduce water pollution in Monona Lake and restore the ecosystem within this project?
- 6. What adverse impact could climate change have on this project, and what solutions would you propose?
- 7. Your submission's weakest section was ____ (where you earned XX% of total points). Please take a few minutes to demonstrate your team's abilities, strengths and approach relating to this section, with particular focus on aspects that Committee members might not have appreciated when reviewing the submitted materials.
