He has served and bartended at the Great Dane, Jolly Bobs, Alchemy, and the Ideal Bar, where he is a Co-owner and Manager. He is co-owner of Ideal Bar, and Star Liquor. Troy lives on the Near East Side where he owns his home and has been part of the community for over 15 years; he also co-owns two income properties in the neighborhood. In addition to his life and work in Madison, he is also an owner of an assisted living home in Waunakee specializing in and known for its quality Dementia care.
