On behalf of the 150 members of the Italian Workmen's Club of Madison (IWC), I'm writing in support of the proposal by CRG to develop the 800 block of Regent Street, by introducing a 10-story student housing complex with commercial space and underground parking.

As part of this project, CRG is willing to dedicate a portion of the new structure to commemorating and honoring the original Greenbush Neighborhood through a mural and a historical timeline calendar.
