Summary

Ekberg recommended a finding of no known historic value for the building at 7601 Portage Road, as there are no City preservation files or WHS site files.

Ekberg provided information from the preservation file on the building at 121 E Wilson Street and said that the building potentially has historic value based on the notoriety of the architects, Law, Law, and Potter, and the importance of the vernacular architecture.

Action

A motion was made by Arnesen, seconded by Tishler, to recommend to the Plan Commission that the building at 7601 Portage Road has no known historic value. The motion passed by voice vote/other.

A motion was made by Taylor, seconded by Arnesen, to recommend to the Plan Commission that the building at 121 E Wilson Street has historic value related to the vernacular context of Madison's built environment and as the work of architects of note, but the building itself is not significant.
