RE: Consideration of a conditional use to add a private school in an existing place of worship in the Traditional Residential-Consistent 1 (TR-C1) District at 4100 Nakoma Road. (LNDUSE-2022-00059; ID 72363)

Dear Kathy and John,

At its August 8, 2022 meeting, the Plan Commission found the standards met and approved your conditional use request for 4100 Nakoma Road. Prior to issuance of permits for the project, the conditions of approval in the following sections shall be satisfied:

Please contact Jeff Quamme of the City Engineering Division–Mapping Section, at (608) 266-4097 if you have questions regarding the following three (3) items:

- 1. Contact the Madison Fire Department for what is needed for wayfinding / directional signage for the school areas.
- 2. Exhibit A header is labeled as Plan of 1st Floor. However, the drawing is labeled as Proposed Ground Floor Plan. Update the labels to represent the proper floor level.
- 3. A building with more than one business / tenant requires multiple addresses. The school tenant shall use the address of 4100 Nakoma Rd Suite 100 for their leased area. The site plan shall reflect a proper street address of the property as reflected by official City of Madison Assessor's and Engineering Division records.

Please contact Bill Sullivan of the Madison Fire Department at (608) 261-9658 if you have any questions regarding the following two (2) items:

- 4. IFC 903.2.3. Provide a fire sprinkler system in Group E occupancies where the fire area is located on a floor other than the level of exit discharge.
- 5. Provide a fire alarm system unless the Group E occupancy has a capacity of 50 people or less. An emergency voice evacuation system would be required if the occupant load exceeds 100.

Please contact Tim Sobota, Metro Transit, at (608) 261-4289 if you have any questions regarding the following two (2) items:

- 6. The applicant shall maintain or replace the accessible bus stop boarding pad at the curbside bus stop zone that is on the north side of Nakoma Road, west of Seminole Highway/Yuma Drive.
- 7. The applicant shall include the location of these transit amenities on the final documents filed with their permit application so that Metro Transit may review the design.

Specific questions regarding the comments or conditions contained in this letter should be directed to the commenting agency.

Please now follow the procedures listed below for obtaining permits for your project:

- 1. After the plans have been revised per the above conditions, please one (1) complete digital plan set in PDF format of complete, fully dimensioned, and to-scale plans; the appropriate site plan review application and site plan review fee (pursuant to Section 28.206 of the Zoning Code); and any other documentation requested herein the Zoning Administrator to at SPRApplications@cityofmadison.com. (Note that that an individual email cannot exceed 20MB and it is the responsibility of the applicant to present files in a manner that can be accepted. Please email SPRApplications@cityofmadison.com regarding questions or if you need alternative filing options. The sets of final revised plans or documents will be circulated by Zoning staff to the City department staff listed above for their final approval.
- 2. The site plan review fee pursuant to Section 28.206 can be mailed in, dropped in the drop box at the Madison Municipal Building, or you can make an appointment at the Zoning counter to pay the fee. Checks should be made out to "City Treasurer." If you mail in the check or use the drop box, please include the application form with the project address and contact information. Zoning staff typically suggest using the drop box or making an appointment with the Zoning counter to pay the fee as they are the quickest.

3. City Agencies who submitted conditions of approval will review your revised plans to verify that their conditions, along with any applicable requirements, have been satisfied. When the revised plans are submitted, the applicant will be emailed a hyperlink to a website to follow, in real time, which agencies have reviewed the revised documents, and signed off or need additional information.

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- 4. This letter shall be signed by the applicant and property owner (if not the applicant) to acknowledge the conditions of approval and returned to the Zoning Administrator when requesting building permit approval. [Signature block on last page]
- 5. No alteration of this proposal shall be permitted unless approved by the Plan Commission, provided, however, the Zoning Administrator may issue permits for minor alterations. No alteration of a conditional use shall be permitted unless approved by the Plan Commission provided, however, the Zoning Administrator following consideration by the alderperson of the district, may approve minor alterations or additions which are approved by the Director of Planning and Community and Economic Development and are compatible with the concept approved by the Plan Commission and the conditional use standards. This approval shall become null and void one (1) year after the date of the Plan Commission unless the use is commenced, construction is under way, or a valid building permit is issued and construction commenced within 6 months of the issuance of said building permit. Where the plans have not been altered from the Plan Commission's approval, and the conditional use has expired, the Director of Planning and Community and Economic Development may, after consultation with the Alderperson of the District, approve an extension for up to 24 months from the expiration date. The Plan Commission shall retain jurisdiction over this matter for the purpose of resolving complaints against the approved conditional use permit.
