Items of Significance since last meeting:

- 3 homicides (2 on 08/12 and 1 on 08/26); all assigned to our Violent Crimes Unit
- 2 fatality crashes:
 - o 08/01/2022: Car vs Bike-Assigned to Traffic Specialists
 - o 08/06/2022: Car vs Pedestrian-Assigned to Traffic Specialists

Updates:

- MPD's steering committee met with Matrix Consulting Group (MCG) on 08/11 to discuss staffing the work groups
- The workgroups are:
 - Madison-Centric Policing: Focusing on community policing specific to Madison
 - Youth Engagement: Creating long-lasting and positive relationships between youth and MPD
 - Communication with the Community: How to improve communication between MPD and all of the various Madison communities
 - Internal MPD Organizational Culture: Improving leadership, internal communications, training, diversity, recruitment and retention
- o On 08/19, the steering committee presented the Chief with recommendations on staffing the workgroups
 - Groups that were solicited include: COB, United Way, the Mayor's office, Common Council, Boys and Girls Club, Big Brothers Big Sisters and Nehemiah (list is not all inclusive)
 - Madison Centric, Community Communication and Youth Engagement are currently comprised of 6 internal (sworn and civilian) and 4 community member
 - Captain Tye working with MCG to get additional community members
 - Internally-email disseminated for volunteers
 - o 11 sworn and civilian employees
- MPD's steering committee met with MCG again on 08/30 to discuss work group progression and the final Strategic Plan Document
 - Discussed formatting, including a forward facing dashboard accessible to the community
 - In lieu of one large document, discussed having an appendix and executive summary
- Next steps: Formalize and coordinate meetings for the workgroups (5-7 year commitment)
