






<u>CITY WIDE:</u> There were 14 reported shots fired incidents in July.

<u>City Wide:</u> - 10 reported robbery offenses in the month of July.

Year to Date: - **75** reported robbery offenses since January 1st, 2022.



July 2022 - Burglaries

<u>City Wide:</u> There were at least 87 burglary cases in the month of July.

Year to Date: There have been at least 441 burglary cases since January 1st, 2022.

3 Year Comparison (July):

• 2019: 151

• 2020: 145


• 2021: 121

• 3-year average: 139

The 87 burglaries in July 2022 is around a 37% decrease over the previous 3-year average.

<u>Burglaries per District:</u> Midtown: 21, West: 17, South: 6, Central: 19, North: 12, East: 12

<u>What:</u> During the course of the 87 reported burglaries, at least 2 firearms were discovered stolen, and 21 victims reported being home at the time.





July 2022 - Heroin Overdoses

<u>City Wide:</u> There were at least 16 heroin overdose calls for service in the month of July. There were 4 fatal heroin overdoses in the month of July.

Year to Date: There have been at least 119 heroin overdose calls for service since January 1st, 2022.

3 Year Comparison (July):



3-year average: 27

The 18 heroin overdoses in July 2022 is a 41% decrease over the previous 3-year average.

Heroin ODs per District: Midtown: 0, West: 2, South: 2, Central: 3, North: 3, East: 6

<u>Heroin fatalities:</u> YTD the City has experienced 18 deaths from heroin overdoses. In July 2022, there were 4 suspected overdose deaths. Compared to the three year average (5) - there is a 20% decrease from July 2022 totals.





July 2022 - Stolen Autos

<u>City Wide:</u> There were at least 79 stolen auto calls for service in the month of July. 71 have been recovered.

Year to Date: There have been at least 373 stolen auto calls for service since January 1st, 2022.

3 Year Comparison (July):

• 2019: 41

2020: 93

• 2021: 79


3-year average: 71

The 79 stolen autos in July 2022 is an 11% increase compared to the previous 3-year average.

Stolen Autos per District: Midtown: 18, West: 16, South: 5, Central: 6, North: 15,

East: 19

<u>What:</u> Of the 79 autos stolen in July, 20 had keys in them or easily accessible. 4 were unlocked and running at the time of the theft.





July 2022 – TFA

<u>City Wide:</u> There were at least 131 TFA offenses in the month of July, 2022.

Year to Date: There have been at least 438 TFA offenses since January 1st, 2022.

3 Year Comparison (July):

• 2019: 129

• 2020: 171

• 2021: 141

• 3-year average: 149

The 131 TFAs in July 2022 is a 12% decrease over the previous 3-year average.

TFAs per District: West: 39, Midtown: 22, South: 18, Central: 11, North: 16, East: 25

<u>What:</u> Of the 131 TFAs in July, 27 were forced entry & 51 were no-force or unlocked & 53 are UNK.
