Summary

Ekberg said that staff recommended a finding of no known historic value for the buildings at 6706 Odana Road, 6714 Odana Road, 415 N Lake Street, 5710 Mineral Point Road, and 1605 Fremont Avenue, as there are no preservation files or WHS site files.

Kaliszewski mentioned that the previous Cuna Mutual building they reviewed for demolition at 5810 Mineral Point Road was found to fit between demolition criteria a/b, mostly as part of the landscape. Now that the round building has been demolished, the site has lost its intact landscape, so she was okay with a finding of no known historic value for the building at 5710 Mineral Point Road.

Action

A motion was made by Taylor, seconded by McLean, to recommend to the Plan Commission that the buildings at 6706 Odana Road, 6714 Odana Road, 415 N Lake Street, 5710 Mineral Point Road, and 1605 Fremont Avenue have no known historic value. The motion passed by voice vote/other.
