We the residents of Normandy Square strongly protest the proposed plans to construct the 6-story apartment building on the Market Square Theatre site. The building will tower over everything else in the area and is within 50 feet of our building. It is unreasonable to put a 6-story building in such close proximity to ours. It will make it very difficult for emergency vehicles to attend to our needs. Please refer to the enclosed, you will find resident comments of their concerns regarding construction of the 6-story apartment building being proposed by Apex Real Estate Holdings and Walter Wayne Development LLC. There are no 6-story buildings in the immediate area nor are there any being proposed.

Normandy Square Apartments is a community of elderly people, many of whom are dependent on scooters, wheelchairs, walkers, and canes in order to live their remaining years with some semblance of mobility, respect, quiet and safety in a secure living environment. The proposed building would cause much hardship and safety concerns to our residents.

We ask that you come and visit us at Normandy Square and see the situation through our eyes. The time will come, in your lives, when you too will be looking through our "windows". Then, we believe, you will agree that our objections are valid. Would you want to be looking at 6 stories of people looking back at you?

We will thank you to give serious consideration to the health and well being of the nearly 100 residents at Normandy Square and consider changing your plans.

I've lived here, at Normandy, for about three years. My room is ample, just right for me, close to a shopping center and a drugstore. If I want, close to Hy-Vee and St. Vincent. I've living a quiet life, minding my own business, working from home, doing exercises every morning, painting, and reading out in the porch at the 1<sup>st</sup> floor or at my apartment. My life has been wonderful.

Since I've heard they are building a 6-story building in front of our building, (6604 Odana Road) I have been upset for different reasons, which is the reason why I'm writing this letter.

The year 2010 was an awful year for me. I suffered three (3) strokes and I almost died. I was living in FL. then. My sister, Ana M. Boatwright brought me to WI, Madison. I lived for 3 years in a Nursing Home, I went to Assisted Living at Heritage for two (2) years, and the I moved to Independent Living for three (3) years. That's when I heard about Normandy, and I though it is fabulous.

As you can see, my life for the last 10+ years it been pretty calm for my health.

My concerts are as follows:

- o I live on the second floor in the front of the building. The air is going to be sandy, dusty, heavy, and powdery, I think for two years (supposed). I suffer from bronchial-asthma.
- I depend on rides: paratransit, transit-solution, MTM, Badger Bus, as I'm not able to drive. As it looks on the map, there's no space for a large car to turn around. It depends on the width of the Lane (street) for it turn. As the bus only has one way for me to enter.
- I suffer from seizures. If needed, I have to call EMS, when they come, also comes the police and the fire trucks. I believe there's no space for them to assist me.
- When you build something that large, you must think on WHO your neighbors are. It completely overshadows my apartment. I'll be looking at my neighbor. That's something I don't want.
- o I've stated my concerns, as they are valid. If you ask me, I would make front of Normandy Lane wider and make the entrance on Odana Road and on the side of Yellowstone Road, and for maintenance make it on the other side. Just leave the Normandy Lane wider and alone.


Has the climate change crisis been addressed in the construction of the proposed 6 story apartment building?

I live on the third floor of Normandy Square across the driveway from the Theatre building and I am concerned about having a 6 story-98 unit apartment building towering over everything else in the area.

- \* I am concerned about the health of our residents.

  With 100+ more people living in close proximity to our building; the "people noise", the noise from so many more cars driving through in front of our building, and the potential noise in the evenings when many seniors are "early to bed."
- \* I am concerned about the "noise pollution" & "air pollution" caused during construction & beyon-
- \* I am concerned that traffic between our building and the proposed building will make it dangerous for many of our residents with walkers and motorized scooters and other health issues to venture out for exercise, shopping or having a friend or Badger Bus take them to appointments.
