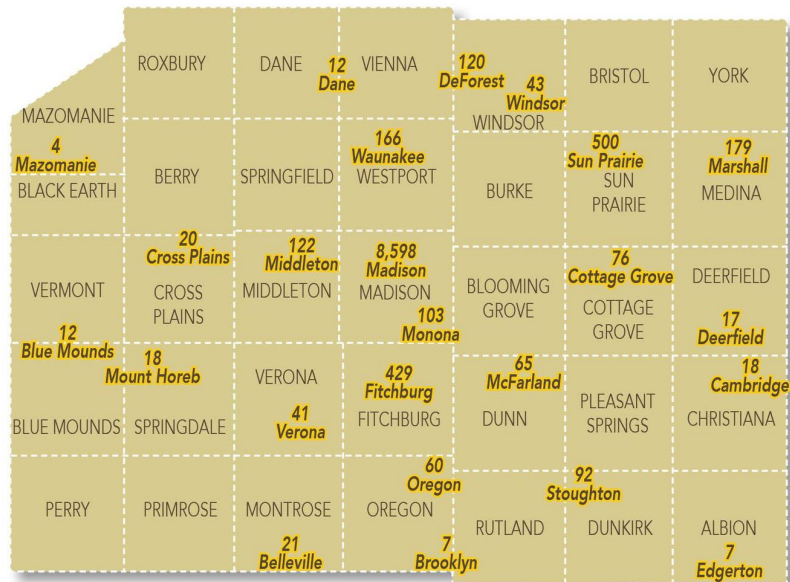
Please see attached notes from 173 of our members from Tuesday, one of our busiest days in the market line, urging their Alders to support The River in Tuesday's amendment vote.
