# **URBAN DESIGN COMMISSION APPROVAL PROCESS**



#### Introduction

The City of Madison's Urban Design Commission (UDC) has been created to:

- Encourage and promote high quality in the design of new buildings, developments, remodeling, and additions so as to maintain and improve the established standards of property values within the City.
- Foster civic pride in the beauty and nobler assets of the City, and in all other ways possible assure a functionally efficient
  and visually attractive City in the future.

# **Types of Approvals**

There are three types of requests considered by the UDC:

- <u>Informational Presentation</u>. A request for an Informational Presentation to the UDC may be requested prior to seeking any approvals to obtain early feedback and direction before undertaking detailed design efforts. Applicants should provide details on the context of the site, design concept, site and building plans, and other relevant information to help the UDC understand the proposal and provide feedback. (Does not apply to CDR's or Signage Modification requests)
- <u>Initial Approval</u>. Applicants may, at their discretion, request Initial Approval of a proposal by presenting preliminary design information. As part of their review, the Commission will provide feedback on the design information that should be addressed at Final Approval stage.
- <u>Final Approval</u>. Applicants may request Final Approval of a proposal by presenting all final project details. Recommendations or concerns expressed by the UDC in the Initial Approval must be addressed at this time.

#### **Presentations to the Commission**

The Urban Design Commission meets virtually via Zoom, typically on the second and fourth Wednesdays of each month at 4:30 p.m. Applicant presentations are strongly encouraged, although not required. Prior to the meeting, each individual speaker is required to complete an online registration form to speak at the meeting. A link to complete the online registration will be provided by staff prior to the meeting. Please note that individual presentations will be limited to a **maximum of three (3) minutes**. The pooling of time may be utilized to provide one speaker more time to present, however the additional time will be based on the number of registrants from the applicant team, i.e. two (2) applicant registrants = six (6) minutes for one (1) speaker.

Primarily, the UDC is interested in the appearance and design quality of projects. Emphasis should be given to the site plan, landscape plan, lighting plan, building elevations, exterior building materials, color scheme, and graphics. Please note that presentation slides, in a PDF file format, are required to be submitted **the Friday before** the UDC meeting.

The email must include the project address, project name, and applicant name.

Dear Commission,

Attached is the proposed sign plan for the Educational Site, Zoned CI, located at 1000 Edgewood College Dr and 2219 Monroe St.

This application requests an amendment to the Edgewood Campus signage plan approved by the Commission at the July 31, 2019 meeting. The request is for one (1) additional building sign for identifying Edgewood High School. The signage plan approved in 2019 focused on signage enhancements for Edgewood College. Currently, Edgewood High School is in the midst of a remodeling project to the exterior of the Commons; the plan incorporates a sign to identify this entrance of the High School.

Per the Madison Sign Control Ordinance, section 31.043(4)(b) Comprehensive Design Review Criteria, below are the seven items required to be addressed. Indented under each item is information to support how we believe each item is satisfied.

1. The Sign Plan shall create visual harmony between the signs, building(s), and building site through unique and exceptional use of materials, design, color, any lighting, and other design elements; and shall result in signs of appropriate scale and character to the uses and building(s) on the zoning lot as well as adjacent buildings, structures and uses.

The sign plan proposed indeed creates visual harmony between the signs, buildings and site and appears to result in signs of appropriate scale and character. The proposed building sign relates to and is intended to be integral to the remodel work underway as well as many of the existing signs which are also internally illuminated. The purpose of the proposed sign is to effectively identify this building entrance. Please note that there is no other "Edgewood High School" sign on the building.

2. Each element of the Sign Plan shall be found to be necessary due to unique or unusual design aspects in the architecture or limitations in the building site or surrounding environment; ...

The proposed building sign is intended to identify the property and direct visitors in an effective manner and does not have the addition of advertising. As stated above, there is no other "Edgewood High School" sign on the building; this fact supports the necessity of the sign.

3. The Sign Plan shall not violate any of the stated purposes described in Secs. 31.02(1) and 33.24(2).

The proposed building sign is not intended to violate any stated purposes of ordinances, and it does not appear to do so.

4. All signs must meet minimum construction requirements under Sec. 31.04(5).

The proposed building sign meets minimum construction requirements of the Chapter 31 Sign Control Ordinance.

5. The Sign Plan shall not approve Advertising beyond the restrictions in Sec. 31.11 or Off-Premise Directional Signs beyond the restrictions in Sec. 31.115.

The proposed building sign is on-premise of the owner's property and does not go beyond the restrictions of Advertising or Off-Premise Directional Signs in the Chapter 31 Sign Control Ordinance.

6. The Sign Plan shall not be approved if any element of the plan: a. presents a hazard to vehicular or pedestrian traffic on public or private property, b. obstructs views at points of ingress and egress of adjoining properties, c. obstructs or impedes the visibility of existing lawful signs on adjacent property, or d. negatively impacts the visual quality of public or private open space.

The proposed building sign is not intended to present hazards, obstruct views, obstruct visibility of lawful signs, or negatively impact visual quality, and it does not appear to do so.

7. The Sign Plan may only encompass signs on private property of the zoning lot or building site in question, and shall not approve any signs in the right of way or on public property.

The proposed building sign is on the owner's private property.

The first three pages of the attached sign plan following the cover page show a depiction of the proposed sign, indication of its location, and current construction progress of the Commons project.

In summary, the proposed sign plan is intended to optimize property identification and effectively inform the public of the Edgewood High School entrance. As such, we are seeking approval of this amendment to the existing signage plan.
