

Apply for a Downtown Performance Space Permit to use amplification and reserve a location for only \$15

Easy + Fun + Creative



This permit is often used for music, speakers, rallies or performances. The locations below can only be reserved 21 days or less before the reservation date. These areas (with the exception of Concrete Park/Frances Plaza) have access to electrical outlets. (Advance notice is required to guarantee electrical access). Amplification is allowed with this permit during the times listed below! Accepting tips is allowed.



A Few Considerations:

- Even battery powered portable amps are included in amplification. No permit is needed if you are not using amplification or set-up (tables, chairs, etc).
- · Vending of any type is not allowed with the Downtown Performance Space permit.
