Currently Funded Services

Direct Provision of Child Care

- Financial support for programs who enroll 25% or more of families identified as low income
- Child Care outside of regular business hours
- Child Care for families that are experiencing barriers
 - Families experiencing homelessness, domestic violence or other barriers to employment or training

Currently Funded Services

Consultation Services

- Reflective Practice
 - Child Care Teaching Staff
 - Child Care Directors
- Program level coaching and technical assistance

Training for Early Childhood Professionals

- Supporting Access to coursework for Spanish speaking providers
- Trainings on brain development and equitable practices

3 Areas of Focus for 2023 RFP

Area 1: Direct Provision of Child Care

- Continuation of the programs and services from previous RFP
 - Support for families experiencing barriers to accessible high-quality care
 - Experiencing homeless
 - Domestic violence
 - Mental and Physical health emergencies
 - ▶ Direct support to programs who's enrollment consists of 25% or more of families who are identified as low-income

3 Areas of Focus for 2023 RFP

Area 2: Social and Emotional Supports and Training

- Funding for Community Wide Pyramid Model Implementation
 - Coaching and Program level consultation
 - Little to no cost training for providers and programs
 - Collaborations between City of Madison and local experts
- Reflective Practice
 - Providing Reflective practice for current and potential City of Madison Accredited Sites

Area 3: Support for child care start ups and expansions

- Technical assistance for providers who look to expand or open new facilities
 - Support for navigating current regulations
 - Support for implementation of City of Madison Accreditation Standards

 - Potential to make funding recommendations for increasing capacity
