Dear commissioners,

If you've ever walked along Harvey Street, you have likely noticed a lot of variation in pedestrian accommodations:

\* From Blackhawk to Eugenia, there is no sidewalk on either side.

\* From Eugenia to Hill, there is a sidewalk on the south side, but only after the first property line.

\* From Hill to Schmitt, there's a sidewalk on the north side, but excluding the properties at either end of the block.

\* From Schmitt to Ridge, there's no sidewalk for the first half (closer to Schmitt), and then there is a sidewalk on the north side for the second half.

\* Another half block without any sidewalks, and then Harvey Street transitions to an alley-like Franklin Ct.

Going on the sidewalk, off the sidewalk, switching sides, dealing with cars, all this makes simply walking down this street--which it supposed to be a lower-stress alternative to University Ave--a lot more complicated than it needs to be. And this is the perspective of someone without mobility limitations. The proposed plan will address a lot of discontinuities here. Obviously not all of them. But it'll be a big improvement for people walking in the area.
