URBAN DESIGN COMMISSION APPROVAL PROCESS



Introduction

The City of Madison's Urban Design Commission (UDC) has been created to:

- Encourage and promote high quality in the design of new buildings, developments, remodeling, and additions so as to maintain and improve the established standards of property values within the City.
- Foster civic pride in the beauty and nobler assets of the City, and in all other ways possible assure a functionally efficient and visually attractive City in the future.

Types of Approvals

There are three types of requests considered by the UDC:

- Informational Presentation. Applicants may, at their discretion, request to make an Informational Presentation to the
 UDC prior to seeking any approvals to obtain early feedback and direction before undertaking detailed design. Applicants
 should provide details on the context of the site, design concept, site and building plans, and other relevant information
 to help the UDC understand the proposal and provide feedback. (Does not apply to CDR's or Signage Variance requests)
- <u>Initial Approval</u>. Applicants may, at their discretion, request initial approval of a proposal by presenting preliminary design information. As part of their review, the Commission will provide feedback on the design information that should be addressed at Final Approval stage.
- <u>Final Approval</u>. Applicants may request Final Approval of a proposal by presenting all final project details. Recommendations or concerns expressed by the UDC in the initial approval must be addressed at this time.

Presentations to the Commission

Primarily, the UDC is interested in the appearance and design quality of projects. Emphasis should be given to the site plan, landscape plan, lighting plan, building elevations, exterior building materials, color scheme, and graphics.

When presenting projects to the UDC, applicants must fill out a registration slip provided in the meeting room and present it to the Secretary. Presentations should generally be limited to 5 minutes or as extended by motion by consent of the Commission. The Commission will withhold questions until the end of the presentation.

Applicants are encouraged to consider the use of various graphic presentation material including a locator map, photographs, renderings/model, scale drawings of the proposal in context with adjacent buildings/uses/signs, etc., as may be deemed appropriate to describe the project and its surroundings. Graphics should be mounted on rigid boards so that they may be easily displayed. Applicants/presenters are responsible for all presentation materials, AV equipment and easels.

Dear Urban Design Commission,

We are requesting your consideration to amend the existing CDR to allow for an increase in size for the wall signage at the entrance that reads, "LA FOLLETTE HIGH SCHOOL. Code allows for a 32 sq. ft. sign and we are requesting a 136 sq. ft. sign. We are also requesting to install (2) sets of identification letters on the canopies over the "Fine arts" entrance, and the "Athletics" entrance.

To the members of the Urban Design Commission:

The approved referendum project design for La Follette High School, at 702 Pflaum Road, includes a small addition to restore La Follette's main entrance and Welcome Center to the south elevation (Pflaum Road). This impactful addition features a unique façade to complement the existing building, which includes new wall signage to identify the primary entrance for staff, students, and community. The building letters, along with exterior wayfinding signage associated with the east elevation facing the high school parking lot, require a modification to the existing approved CDR for La Follette High School and Sennett Middle School.

A key element of the Madison Metropolitan School District Strategic Framework is elevating a sense of Belonging for staff and students. MMSD schools are also community fixtures and landmarks within their neighborhoods. High school buildings in particular provide event space and amenities for users beyond the staff and student user base.

The objective of the new sign near the primary high school entrance is both conceptual and practical; the prominent "La Follette" graphic near the welcome center references Lancer Pride and our core MMSD value of Belonging; the size and design of the architectural façade evokes the design concept of "Soul of the City" for La Follette's reimagining; and the building entrance hierarchy is clear to pedestrians. The proposed sign is a graphic element, which the south facade was designed to display, and is therefore at a larger scale than the 32 net sf allowable for school signage without a CDR. The scale is, however, sensitive to the overall size of the collective south elevations of La Follette and Sennett Middle School, a combination site that is home to two schools, and the significant setback from Pflaum Road.

Along La Follette's east elevation, facing the parking lot, an amendment to the existing CDR is requested to replace the wall-mounted ancillary entrance signs with above-canopy text. The design of the new entrances includes deep canopies, as design features and wayfinding signals, and above-canopy signage will be more visible than the existing wall-mounted signage. Without a modification to the existing CDR, these above-awning signs would not be allowable in a Group 1 District.

Thank you for your review of these proposed amendments to the La Follette High School/Sennett Middle School CDR. In the context of La Follette's reimagining, MMSD believes the modified signs provide significant value to the ease of wayfinding and display of school pride. MMSD understands that any future changes to signage, including at Sennett Middle School, would require an additional review of the CDR.

Comprehensive Design Review Criteria:

1) The proposal shall create visual harmony between the signs, building(s), and building site through unique and exceptional use of materials, design, color, any lighting, and other design elements; and shall result in signs of appropriate scale and character to the uses and building(s) on the zoning lot as well as adjacent buildings, structures and uses.

Entry Sign:

The metal "LA FOLLETTE HIGH SCHOOL" sign was designed in unison with the new perforated metal "screen" façade, metal panel fascia canopy, and metal framing supports to create a formal building entrance with the desired visual harmony of like materials. The architectural features presented in this remodeling work hand in hand to redevelop this relict morphological unit, the school, and create an exciting and stimulating main entrance to the building that utilizes modern material formations as a language to provide an updated context and inviting environment that is recognizable in space by the patrons of this public facility. The contrast of the metal mesh to the metal sign allows for the copy to be legible from a greater distance visually by pedestrians and vehicles alike while still maintaining a like material basis. The entry signage further distinguishes itself from the other proposed canopy signs and entrances by existing on the mesh façade in a larger size, so as to establish a hierarchy within the entrance formations and built environment which further promotes the language of "main" entrance to the public so as to not be misconstrued with the tertiary entrances.

Canopy Wayfinding Signage:

The "LA FOLLETTE FINE ARTS" and "LA FOLLETTE ATHLETICS" canopy signs create a visual harmony with the canopies and surrounding architectural features; the signs identify each specific building entrance without overpowering the surrounding architectural features.

2) Each element shall be found to be necessary due to unique or unusual design aspects in the architecture or limitations in the building site or surrounding environment; except that when a request for an Additional Sign Code Approval under Sec. 31.043(3) is included in the Comprehensive Design Review, the sign(s) eligible for approval under Sec. 31.043(3) shall meet the applicable criteria of Sec. 31.043(3), except that sign approvals that come to Comprehensive Design Review from MXC and EC districts pursuant to 31.13(3) and (7) need not meet the criteria of this paragraph.

Entry Sign:

The "screen" façade was designed to clearly identify the main entrance to the building. The "LA FOLLETTE HIGH SCHOOL" sign is designed to compliment the unique "screen" façade design and further identify the main entrance. The size increase is needed to allow pedestrians, and the public to denote the identity of this building as being a public-school facility. The 32 Square foot maximum allowed signage area does not provide sufficient signable area when compared to the scale of the new mesh wall. The scale of the mesh wall and other architectural features on the building entrance work against the identifiable nature of the sign when depicted at a smaller scale and would hinder the ability to see it when at a distance. The increased size proposed utilizes a similar scale profile to the existing architectural details and would allow it to provide a cohesive design while also depicting its identity in space to the public for which it serves.

Canopy Wayfinding Signage:

The "LA FOLLETTE FINE ARTS" and "LA FOLLETTE ATHLETICS" signs are necessary to identify specific event related entrances and highlight the unique canopy design at these locations on the building. The letters need to be presented on the canopy edge so as to not be visually impeded by the canopy itself.

3) The proposal shall not violate any of the stated purposes described in Secs. 31.02(1) and 33.24(2)

Entry Sign:

The proposed "welcome to LA FOLLETTE HIGH SCHOOL" sign does not violate the stated purposes described in Secs. 31.02(1) and 33.24(2).

Canopy Wayfinding Signage:

The proposed "LA FOLLETTE FINE ARTS" and "LA FOLLETTE ATHLETICS" canopy signs do not violate the stated purposes described in Secs. 31.02(1) and 33.24(2).

4) All signs must meet minimum construction requirements under Sec. 31.04(5).

Entry Sign:

The proposed "welcome to LA FOLLETTE HIGH SCHOOL" sign will meet or exceed all minimum construction requirements under Sec. 31.04(5).

Canopy Wayfinding Signage:

The proposed "LA FOLLETTE FINE ARTS" and "LA FOLLETTE ATHLETICS" canopy signs will meet or exceed all minimum construction requirements under Sec. 31.04(5).

5) The proposal shall not approve Advertising beyond the restrictions in Sec. 31.11 or Off-Premise Directional Signs beyond the restrictions in Sec. 31.115.

The La Follette High School sign proposal does not include advertising or off-premise signage.

- 6) The proposal shall not be approved if any element of the plan:
 - a. presents a hazard to vehicular or pedestrian traffic on public or private property,
 - b. obstructs views at points of ingress and egress of adjoining property,
 - c. obstructs or impedes the visibility of existing lawful signs on adjacent property, or
 - d. negatively impacts the visual quality of public or private open space.

The La Follette high School sign proposal does not violate any of the aforementioned items.

7) The proposal may only encompass signs on private property of the zoning lot or building site in question and shall not approve any signs in the right of way or on public property.
All proposed signage is located on the La Follette High School grounds.














